“ Program Notes - ‘Pledge of Allegiance’ – ‘What it Means’ ”

In one of his many “skits” & numerous Characters Red’s “School Principal” character is concerned that the children have come to reciting the “Pledge of Allegiance” as a chore with out any enthusiasm. The Principal then begins to explain the significance of the “Pledge of Allegiance”.



I --- Me; an individual; a committee of one

P LEDGE --- Dedicate all of my worldly goods to give without self-pity.

ALLEGIANCE --- My love and devotion.

TO THE FLAG --- Our standard; Old Glory; a symbol of freedom; wherever she waves there is respect, because your loyalty has given her dignity that shouts – freedom is everybody’s job.

UNITED --- That means we have all come together.

STATES --- Individual communities that have united into forty-eight (Now “50”) great states. Forty - eight states (Now“50”) individual communities with pride and dignity and purpose. All divided with imaginary boundaries, yet united to a common purpose, and love for country.

AND TO THE REPUBLIC --- Republic – a state in which sovereign power is invested in individual Representatives chosen by the people to govern. And government is the people; and it’s from the people to the leaders, NOT from the leaders to the people.

FOR WHICH IT STANDS

ONE NATION --- One Nation so blessed by God.

AND JUSTICE --- The principle, or qualities, of dealing fairly with others.

President Ron Raleigh continued the program by stating “I believe that 95% of the American people, regardless of their political alliance, ethnicity, or any other divisible cliché are good, caring, and love our country. There are those that would deny the symbol of America, our American Flag, as racist, a symbol of hate, etc and would have it changed. The 95%’ers must continue to uphold our country and our Flag.

“Flag Trivia”

- * The current “50” Star Flag has been in active use longer than any other American National Flag – “61” years July 5th 2021.
- * Fourteen Presidents have served under the “50” Star Flag.
- * The American Flag has “flown” over battlefields around the world and on US soil since 1777.
- * Betsy Ross sewed the first American Flag and many others followed. All past American Flags can be flown legally.
- * The same flag that flew over Pearl Harbor December 7th, 1941 flew again over the White House on August 14th, 1945 – the day the Japanese signed the terms of surrender.
- * President **George W. Bush** signed into law the National Defense Authorization Act of 2008 – included in the Act was a change in Flag etiquette allowing veterans to salute the American Flag whether in uniform or not.
